SPANISH TRANSLATION OF THE ROMAN MISSAL AND LECTIONARY DELAYED

Please be aware that there is a Spanish translation of the Roman Missal from Mexico but this is NOT approved for use in the USA and therefore should NOT be purchased as a substitute for waiting for the approved version by the USCCB.

LAY LITURGICAL MINISTRY GUIDELINES & PROTOCOLS

Bishop Cistone has recently promulgated the "Guidelines & Protocols for Liturgical Ministers" for use in the Diocese of Saginaw.

These guidelines will affect the formation of all liturgical ministers and the management of those ministers within the Diocese.

This document will be introduced to the priests and pastoral administrators in December during their quarterly meeting with Bishop Cistone.

Catechetical workshops are being developed by the Office of Liturgy and will be conducted at the parishes in 2015.
