Conducting the Appeal

Roles and Responsibilities

The most successful diocesan annual appeals at the parish level are those in which parish staff and others in the parish community are engaged in the purpose of an appeal and are strong in delivering messages.

Parish leaders may opt to have both staff and parishioners on their Christ's Mission Appeal teams; however, this is not mandatory.

If you do have both parish staff and parishioners on your Christ's Mission Appeal team, the following are suggestions of how to share responsibilities.

Responsibilities of the Pastor/Director of Parish Life

The pastor/director of parish life is the key leader in the parish. No program can hope to succeed without support and positive leadership from the top. No matter how capable others assisting with the Christ's Mission Appeal may be, they take their cue from the pastor/director of parish life.

The pastor/ director of parish life sets the tone for the motivation and success of a project such as Christ's Mission Appeal. Parishioners respond to their priest/director of parish life's enthusiasm, leadership, and confidence. The pastor/director of parish life must be committed to and actively follow the Appeal plan and provide spiritual guidance and teaching.

The roles and responsibilities of pastors/director of parish life within each individual parish will vary, but will most likely include:

- Recruit a knowledgeable, organized, and responsible individual to accept the leadership role as the Christ's Mission Appeal chairperson and the role of the Secretary for the Appeal
- Provide leadership to lay volunteers who are part of the Appeal.
- A pastor/director of parish life should make his/her own personal pledge commitment to the Appeal before asking others to give. Communication about this pledge is powerful as it reflects the parish leadership's belief in the Appeal.
- Promote the Appeal positively from the pulpit and at parish meetings, using a stewardship
 orientation towards making a gift to the Christ's Mission Appeal in gratitude for God's many gifts
 and blessings. Explanations of how Appeal-supported programs help individuals and parish
 activities also are key.
- Discuss the needs, reasons, and expectations of the Appeal at all Masses.
- Offer occasional encouragement on the importance of fulfilling their Christ's Mission Appeal pledge in a timely manner.

Responsibilities of the Parish Chairperson

The Christ's Mission Appeal chairperson serves as the spokesperson for the Appeal. He/she is an important partner in communicating the message of the Appeal to the congregation.

If a parish stewardship commission exists, it is recommended that the Christ's Mission Appeal chairperson should be a member. A consistent message of stewardship will enhance not only the Appeal, but also gifts to the parish of time, talent, and financial resources.

The two primary responsibilities of the chairperson are, 1) to build excitement and enthusiasm for the Appeal, and 2) to implement strategies designed to encourage gifts.

The responsibilities of the chairperson include:

- Building a strong, faith-filled parish Christ's Mission Appeal team is essential to a successful Appeal effort. The team should include dedicated parishioners who have histories of stewardship toward the parish, are involved in parish life, and are committed to seeing the parish succeed.
- Contributing the integrity of his/her name and position to the Appeal. He/she works closely with the pastor/director of parish life to coordinate parish Christ's Mission Appeal efforts and serves as the motivator of the Appeal team. The chair sets the tone of high expectations and serves as a spokesperson for the Appeal.
- Speaking at Masses and to parish groups to promote the Appeal, if requested.
- Familiarizing himself/herself with printed Christ's Mission Appeal materials, especially the list of ministries funded by the Appeal.
- Making a pledge to the Appeal before asking anyone else to do so, thus, promoting support for Christ's Mission Appeal among parishioners.

Responsibilities of Parish Staff

Parish receptionists and secretaries often receive the calls about Christ's Mission Appeal and therefore, are important partners in all efforts to communicate the Appeal's message. Parish receptionists, secretaries, pastors/directors of parish life, and Appeal chairpersons all need to work together to ensure that everyone has Appeal information.

The Appeal Secretary plays a critical role in the Appeal since she/he has great working knowledge of the parish. The Appeal Secretary must keep accurate, confidential records of gifts to the Appeal and needs access to an accurate parish roster in order to update any changes that occur during the Appeal.

The Appeal Secretary is asked to ensure that the following tasks are completed:

- Keep parish stats up to date. The best way to keep lists current is to send changes, as requested by the diocese, on a regular basis so that the GlobaFile list is current. Regular updates will ensure that the contact information used by the diocese is current and reliable.
- Send all completed pledge cards and payments to the diocese following procedures as outline in the Transmittal Manual
- Work with the pastor/director of parish life to assure the Appeal is promoted in bulletins, website, etc.

Promoting the Christ's Mission Appeal

Play the CD and/or video – The 2020 CD and video features a message from Bishop Gruss and an overview of some of the many services and ministries supported by the Christ's Mission Appeal.

Make the case for support – Review the manuals and brochure. In writing and talking about Christ's Mission Appeal, share how any of these ministries have affected you personally or how your parishioners have benefited. The more you personalize the appeal through real life examples, the more informed parishioners are about the Appeal -- and the more motivated they will be to give.

Demonstrate values – Christ's Mission Appeal funds ministries and programs that many parishes cannot provide on their own due to limited financial resources or expertise. Some examples include forming seminarians, assessing schools to help them achieve academic excellence and accreditation, and training parish bookkeepers and catechists to be effective in their work/ministry. Let your parishioners know that these services are provided at no charge to parishes and the benefit that's derived from them.

Localize and personalize – Compile information about your parish's utilization of Christ's Mission Appeal-funded diocesan services and resources throughout the year – not just during the Appeal - such as: parish council, committee or trustee training resource materials and support; parish offertory or budgeting assistance; guidance regarding music and liturgical ministry to strengthen the parish's worship experience; or the welcoming of a newly ordained deacon or priest that benefited from a seminary education.

Lead by example – Your personal example of stewardship and financial support to Christ's Mission Appeal speaks volumes.

Use Christ's Mission Appeal Bulletin Inserts – Parishioners will contribute to Christ's Mission Appeal when they understand the ways it helps fellow Catholics throughout the diocese. The bulletin inserts/materials included are intended to provide more detailed information and personal testimonials on some of the ministries that touch the lives of people throughout the diocese.

 - 1. Your support of the Christ's Mission Appeal helps to support the training of lay ministers who serve in parishes throughout the Diocese of Saginaw. Education for this important ministry includes four years of theology and faith formation. Nearly 400 people, including <names of lay ministers> from our parish serve individual churches and communities as lay ministers.
 - 2. When months for harvesting crops in our region approach, migrant workers travel to our communities to work in the fields. Christ's Mission Appeal funds programs through the Office of Hispanic Ministries to help to bring faith formation and the sacraments to our Catholic brothers and sisters who labor on our farms.
 - 3. Christ's Mission Appeal helps fund many faith offerings and retreats available to the people of our parishes to help them grow as disciples. In addition, the diocesan Faith Formation Office supports leaders in parishes who provide youth ministry and adult faith formation.
 - 4. Your support of the Christ's Mission Appeal helps to bring healing to the divorced. The staff of the Tribunal of the Diocese of Saginaw trains volunteers known as "advocates" to work with people who have experienced a divorce and who want to obtain a declaration of nullity. Christ's Mission Appeal helps make this service possible. Thank you for your gift.
 - 5. Central Michigan University and Saginaw Valley State University have strong campus ministry programs that are made possible through your gifts to Christ's Mission Appeal. The priests and volunteers ministering on college campuses are continually working to make the Catholic faith available to students in dynamic ways. Vibrant liturgies, involving students in ministerial leadership positions, lively discussions that focus on the teachings of the church, travel to conferences, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and spiritual retreats such as Kononia, (which means "community") are offered twice per year. These are samples of the many ways students are called to prayer and a deepening of their faith through campus ministry programs.
 - 6. The FAITH Saginaw magazine will be increasing to six issues a year -- mailed to all parishioners of the Diocese of Saginaw. The magazine shares inspirational stories and educational articles and reports special events throughout the diocese. Your gifts to Christ's Mission Appeal help to make this publication possible. The magazine is created by the Office of Communication, which is funded in part by the Christ's Mission Appeal.

- 7. Your gifts to Christ's Mission Appeal allow the Vicar General to serve the 56 parishes of the Diocese. He works closely with pastors and pastoral administrators to help ensure that parish reorganizations are proceeding according to plans. He also connects parishes with diocesan offices and services when a specific parish need is identified. The services of the Vicar General are one of the many ministries offered through the office of the Bishop made possible by your gift to Christ's Mission Appeal.
- 8. There are a growing variety of addictions that can lead to the deterioration of relationships and marriages. They include: gambling, working too many hours, over involvement with computers, texting and other technology, pornography, drug, alcohol and food addictions, just to name a few. Counseling at Catholic Family Service can help with these issues. Your gifts to Christ's Mission Appeal result in a subsidy to Catholic Family Service to offer these services.
- 9. After the March for Life in Washington D.C., the young people of our diocese who attend take part in a night of formation where they learn more about the various aspects of abortion and the importance of developing a Respect Life culture. March for Life, which is coordinated by the Offices of the Bishop, Christian Service, and Youth Ministry, is a powerful experience for our young people. Your gifts to the Christ's Mission Appeal help make this strong Respect Life experience possible as well as help fund a local March for Life.
