## Let MI Kids Learn Update and Reminder

Dear Diocese of Saginaw Community,

We are now in the final weeks for the *Let MI Kids Learn* petition drive. This effort would enable Michigan children from low-income families to qualify for "Student Opportunity Scholarships" toward their out-of-pocket educational costs at public or nonpublic schools for tutoring, school supplies, computers, and <u>tuition</u>, among other expenses. Donors to scholarship organizations would receive a state tax credit. Low-income parishioners and members of your community would benefit from this initiated legislation, regardless of where they send their children to school. As a reminder:

- 1. This effort is supported by the Michigan Catholic Conference (MCC). Information from the MCC on this matter can be found <u>here</u>.
- 2. This effort contains two specific petitions. For this effort to be successful, sufficient valid signatures must be gathered for each petition.
  - a. The first petition creates the Student Opportunity Scholarship.
  - b. The second petition creates the mechanism to fund the scholarships by allowing for tax credits to individuals and companies who make contributions to the scholarship-granting funds.
- 3. Petition forms should be available at your parish and/or Catholic school. (Forms are also available from the Diocese and can be picked up from the front desk.)
- 4. The petition deadline is May 11, 2022
