



LAST CALL, Let MI Kids Learn Petition Drive

Dear Catholic School Families and Supporters of Catholic Education,

The deadline for submitting completed petition forms for the Let MI Kids Learn is quickly approaching. If you have a form(s) with at least one valid signature, please return that form now. As a reminder:

- Similar bills were previously vetoed by the governor. Each petition requires 340,000 valid signatures to be placed before the legislature. If approved by the legislature, it would not require the governor's signature to become law.
- The process includes two separate but related petitions. One petition allows for the creation of the scholarship granting organizations (SGOs). The second petition amends Michigan tax code to allow for a tax credit for contribution to a SGO.
- If successful, this process would allow eligible families to apply for scholarships to offset various education expenses, including tuition. Children with disabilities, in the foster-care system, or those eligible based on household size and income would be able to apply for funds.
